The Provincial Tax is the same for all at 11% as well as the Federal levy at 0.8%.

Regulations and Information

General

All Pari-Mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. All tickets should be held until the race is declared official and the prices are posted. Notice boards are located in the Grandstand. The approximate odds represent only the probable payout price of the win pool at the time they are posted and have no bearing on the payout price of any other pool.

Where the appropriate odds for any horse posted at "1 to 9" the pay out price based on a \$2.00 ticket in the win pool may be \$2.10. Where the approximate odds for any horse are posted as "99:1", the pay out price based on a \$2.00 ticket in the win pool may be greater than \$200.00.

As per Provincial Regulatory Rules, no person under the age of 19 shall purchase or cash a Pari-Mutuel ticket.

A winning ticket is valid indefinitely.

Entries and Mutuel Fields

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person. "Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an entry or mutual field shall be considered a bet on all horses in the entry or mutual field starts in the race. All tickets purchased on the entry or mutual field remains valid.

Daily Double Betting (Including Late Double)

A "Daily Double" is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the winners of each of the two races specified for the daily double. The daily double is operated as an entirely separate pool and is not affected by wagering in other pools opened on the daily double races. Should a horse or horses (not coupled with a starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the daily double after the first race of the daily double has been declared official, holder of tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first daily double race shall participate in a Consolation Daily Double.

Exactor Betting

An Exactor bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two horses representing different betting interest to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated. If the same betting interest finishes first and second (i.e. 1-1-, 2-2), the payout will be on the horses finishing first and third.

Quinella Betting

A Quinella bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two horses representing different interest to finish, in either order to finish in the race on which the pool is operated. If the same betting interest finishes first and second (i.e. 1-1-, 2-2), the payout will be on the horses finishing first and third.

Triactor Betting

A Triactor bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first three horses representing different interest to finish, in the exact official order to finish, in the race in which the pool is operated.

Superfecta Betting

A Superfecta is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first four horses representing different betting interest to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Pick 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 Pools

The Pick 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the 3, 4, 5, 6, or 7 successive races specified for the Pick 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 respectively. Winning tickets and a mandatory payout of the pick 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 are determined in the following sequence: a) winners of all legs, b) most winners, c) most second place finishes or d) sequentially thereafter. Where no tickets have been sold coupling the official winners of every leg of the Pick 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 and a mandatory payout does not apply, 25% of the day's net pool is paid out as detailed above while 75% is accumulated and carried over.

Pick 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 Scratches

In the event a Pick 3, 4, 5, 6, or 7 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the pick 3, 4, 5, 6, or 7 the favorite as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratched occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favorites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the scratched horse.

Refunds

Subject to the regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded where the race is cancelled, declared no contest, postponed beyond the racing card for which it was scheduled, subject to a change in distance after betting has commenced, or where the running or the finish of the race can not be properly judged.

Common Pool Wagering (Intertrack Betting)

Subject to the regulations, in the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure, various courses of action may result depending on the nature of the breakdown. Bets from the affected sites, including advance bets, may be refunded. Customers will be advised of the course of action.

Outstanding uncashed tickets from January 1, 2019 to March 31, 2019: \$6,684.21.

The Breaking Rule

All prices in Canada must be broken to the nickel as per section 204 of the Criminal Code of Canada. For every \$1.00 bet, the minimum winning amount you will get is \$1.05 for each dollar wagered.

Drug Testing

Drug testing ensures the integrity of all races contested at Northside Downs and in conjunction with the Atlantic Provinces Harness Racing Commission pre-race blood gas analysis are conducted at random on selected horses. Post race urine tests are conducted according to the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency regulations.

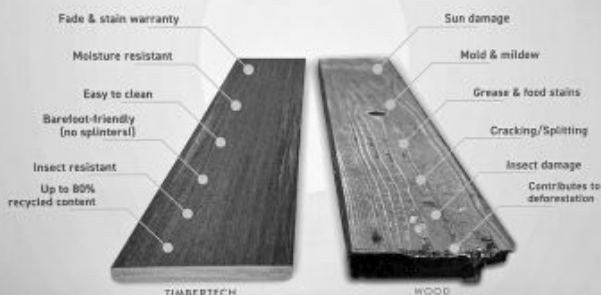
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Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

2 Types of bets



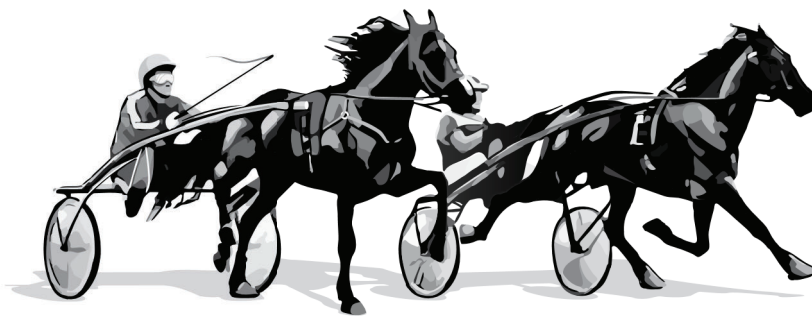
Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	UUU	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	UU	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	UUUU	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	UUUUUU	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Triactor*	UUUUUUU	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	UUUUUUUU	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.
Pick 4	UUUUUUUU	Pick the winner for 4 consecutive races, big payoff possible. This typically starts in race 4. They you pick race 4-5-6 and 7
Pick 5	UUUUUUUUU	Pick the winner for 5 consecutive races, big payoff possible. This typically starts in race 2. They you pick race 2-3-4-5 and 6

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order. For more information visit

Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

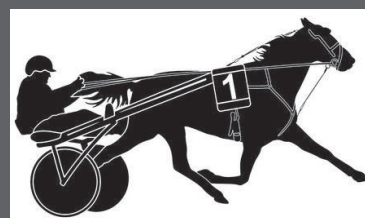
Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcastcommentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses withcurrent odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the **FAVOURITE** pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the **FAVOURITE** pay 53% of the time **SHOW BETS** on the **FAVOURITE** pay 67% of the time

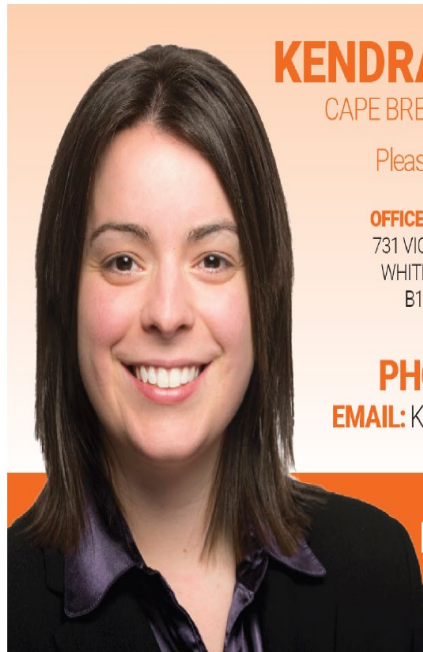

Harold LeBlanc Sr.

April 17, 1939 – July 17, 2026



Harold LeBlanc began his involvement in harness racing in the late 1950's with friend Russell MacDonald from New Waterford. He first began training and driving in 1967. He began a more established racing stable with father-in-law and long-time partner Bob Jardine. In the 1970's they continued to acquire better stock. This was highlighted by a 1976 yearling filly from New Jersey purchased by Harold and his wife Joyce, Jersey Meadow. The mare was named 1979 Horse of the Year in Sydney and broke the all age track record at Inverness in 1980. She was followed by a string of top-class horses in the LeBlanc stable. Advdquu, Tres Tres Grand and Phalen Bob won at the highest level in Sydney covering the next 15 years.

In the late 70's Harold acquired property and constructed a top-quality barn and track just outside of Sydney with a lot of hard work and time from the family, moving the horses onsite in 1980. A number of close friends and trainers have stabled there over the years, including Danny Morrison, Ronnie Seymour, Willie Seymour, Kevin Bailey, Jack Ellsworth, Ian McKinnon, and Charlie Burns to name a few.

Harold had great support from his family, sons Harold Jr and Joel, grandson Brett working with the horses, and the girls Linda, Bobbie and Katie cheering him on. Together they had great success with Southwind Ricardo capturing 3 Horse of the Year Awards, 2 Governor's Cups, and retiring as Northside Downs all time winningest horse. Last October, the LeBlanc Family was recognized during the Atlantic Breeders Crown Banquet for a lifetime in racing.

He recognized the importance of the Houseowner's Association and served a number of terms as President. He was also a founding board member for Harness Racing Cape Breton which brought racing back to Northside Downs.

Harold has trained or driven horses in seven decades, still active as an owner right up to his death last week, with Windemere Ryan winning his last 2 starts of his long life in the game he loved so much.

#1 NAUTI BEACH is a two-year-old homebred Somewhere Fancy filly for the Big M. She was impressive the first time we seen her back on June 20th in a qualifying effort in line to Marc Campbell, pacing in 2:04:4 with a nice 29.2 last quarter, making up almost 8 lengths in the stretch. Her lone pari-mutual effort was against "A" division fillies at Truro where she made a break in the early going but rallied to pickup a cheque. She had a tightener qualifying effort last week by herself stopping the clock in 2:04.3. She gets rail control being the lone rookie in the field of seven & I like the speedy fillies chance of picking up her first lifetime win to kickstart the 10-dash card.

#4 A FIGHTING CHANCE was involved in the first race no contest last week, the start before that one the stallion son of Bet The Moon shined, upsetting Last Chance for catch driver Mark Pezzarello earning his first lifetime win in an impressive score of 2:00:2. He draws the middle of the gate today for Mark & should be forwardly placed when the wings fold, he is in with a great shot at picking up his second win & is the other I would consider for early daily double tickets.

#6 MOONLIGHT debuted for Jayce Mercer in last weeks no contest, the free-legged son of Bet The Moon gets stuck with the dreaded post 6 today but has some considerable class relief compared to what he had to face in PEI. Shawn Lynk can map out a good trip from a tough spot to land on the ticket for the first time in 2026 with the camera-shy gelding.

#4 THUNDER ALLEY is one of two in here dropping out of the top-class Winners Over, the classy 42-time winner has missed the board in his last three starts in the top class, leaving from the far outside in his last two. He dropped & popped back on June 27th in line to catch driver Mark Pezzarello & the hot stable of Heather Hawkins in a seasonal best 1:57.4. He draws the middle of the gate in a short but extremely competitive group of 6 pacers for Kevin Bailey. This is a great betting race in the opening leg of the pick 5 which offers a juicy \$575 carryover today, I like the son of Mystery Chase to go right down the road for Kevin on the drop down in class.

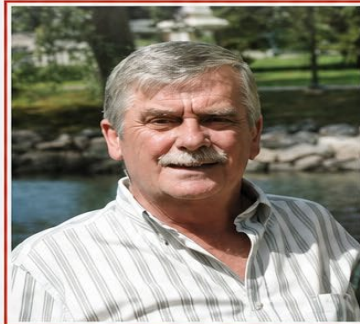
#1 ELM GROVE QWIGGLY was a beaten favourite in this \$1001L5 condition last week for trainer/driver Larry Snow, he was out most of the way in that start but still held tough to finish third in 1:58.1. He draws the coveted rail position today for the first time since returning to the track where it all started for him five years ago. He has some serious speed to his outside, but I think Larry can map out a great trip in this spot & cannot be left off pick 5 tickets.

#2 WINDEMERE RYAN has proven to be a great purchase for team Leblanc as the classy veteran son of Malicious has picked up two wins & a second in his last three starts. He went wire to wire in this condition at the Inverness Raceway two starts back for Harold Leblanc Jr in 1:59.4 & took his seasonal best of 1:59.1 the start before that with co-owner Brett Leblanc in the sulky. He gets a great post to work with again today for Harold & should get a great trip in this extremely competitive race.

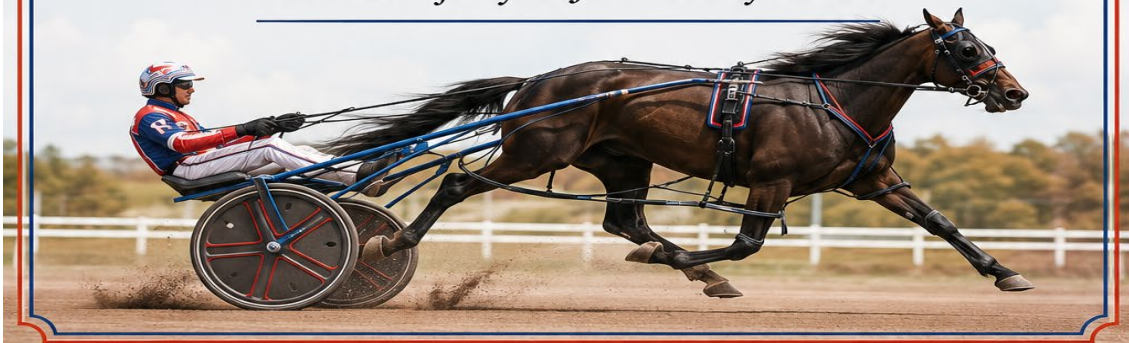

#5 KEEPEROFTHEREALM has finished second in his last two starts at this bottom level condition for Gussy Burns & trainer Bobby Campbell, the 17-time winner could not reel in a sharp Last Chance last week in line to Bobby but did pace in 2:02 in his runner up effort. He gets stuck with an outside post today but does reunite with Ryan Campbell on the slight drop down in class. There is not a ton of gate speed to his inside so I can see Ryan taking an aggressive approach in this spot & I love him to get rid of the goose egg in the win column in 2026 today.

#2 ELM GROVE QWINN got issued a Regent Street parking ticket last week by Windemere Fluster in this bottom level condition, from an outside post she was sent first over in the second quarter by Mark Pezzarello to challenge the leader but could not clear to the lead & faded to sixth but ended up getting placed fifth due to interference in the opening turn. Keigan Madden picks up a live catch drive on the Jamie Hogan trainee today & she gets a much better post to work with. I think she will get a garden trip behind our top choice & is the other would consider for pick 5 tickets.

#8 TEN MILE BEACH exits the same race as our top choice where he picked up a cheque for Willie Seymour & catch driver Shawn Lynk. The 19-time winner gets some slight class relief today & gets a back tier post to work with for the second time in four starts in 2026. He now has three starts under his belt in his 11-year-old season & he shaved almost two full seconds on his last start. Shawn can find some cover to follow from the back tier post & can land on the ticket for the first time this season with the chestnut gelding.

At the 2007 annual awards banquet, the year was capped off for Ray when he was selected for the President's Award from the President Butch Hawco, for the "recognition of Ray's dedication and determination to make this ADVENTURE successful!"

It is with heavy hearts that the family of JW Beather lay to rest their husband, father, brother uncle and friend. Service on September 14th was held for family and close friends.



Born in 1956 in Niagara Falls and raised in Port Hood, John William was the oldest of eight children of the late Donald and Mary Beaton. John Willie (JW) was well known throughout the island and touched a much wider circle throughout the horse community.

JW's lifetime career was working in the construction industry as a masonry labourer and primarily worked for Brimac Masonry, but outside of work his real passion that never waned was for harness racing. Since he was a youngster, JW started attending the races in Inverness with his father. He would then begin going to the racetrack in Port Hood where he would help groom and jog horses and would spend many of his summers at Donmar Farms in Balls Creek under the guidance of Donald Rankin Sr.

After graduating high school, JW traveled to Pompano Park in Florida to work with the racehorses and would later receive his driver's license while working in Saint John, N.B. After working away for some time, JW returned home to Port Hood and started driving in Inverness. Since then, JW raced at all the tracks around the Maritimes, especially at Tartan Downs, Northside Downs, and Inverness Raceway, and has owned and trained Standardbreds with his wife Kim for many years. JW continued to catch drives for various other owners, totaling 993 lifetime wins, until his health issues began the last few years.

JW has been inducted into the Cape Breton Horseman's Hall of Fame and has enjoyed his racing passion as it truly was a lifelong experience right up to his passing.

JW will be remembered for his story telling, humour, fullness of life, and love for the dance floor. JW will be immensely missed by all his family and friends.

He gets a back tier draw to work with today & the classy son of McArdle is too hot to go against in the anchor leg of the pick 5.

#2 **SUNNY BO** was hounded by a stubborn Red Rum She Wrote on Monday evening, the 35-time winner landed on the front for trainer/driver John Hawco but could not sneak in a breather with the defending 2025 Governors Cup champion breathing down his neck the whole way. He still put forward a good effort just narrowly missing by a quarter of a length finishing third in the photo finish. He stays put in this optional \$5,000 claimer today for team Hawco & is back on a regular race rotation after missing a week before his last start. She should get a garden trip behind our top choice & is the other one I would use in pick 4 tickets.

#7 **SUNSHINE LUCAS** narrowly missed as my best bet on Monday evening; Kevin Bailey pointed the handsome son of Sunshine Beach to the lead off the rail & looked to be well on his way to his fourth lifetime win, but he was collared late by Sidekick who had the perfect pocket ride. A back tier post behind our two top selections should see him getting a great trip today, he can hit the ticket for the tenth time in just twelve starts.

He cruised to an easy score on Monday evening in line to the Big M stopping the clock in 2:01.4 with a snappy 29.1 closing quarter. The optional \$7,000 claimer is where his connections decided to put him today & that claiming tag becomes just over \$10,000 with allowances, he gets an outside post for Ardon today so if he wants to make it four in a row, he will have to do it from off the pace but he is too hot to go against right now.

#2 **DAVID LLOYD GEORGE** also comes into this optional \$7,000 claimer riding a win streak, the American Ideal gelding drew two inside posts last week & was a gate to wire winner in both starts, winning in 2:00.3 at the Inverness Raceway & then followed it up Monday evening with another 2:00.3 victory. Another great post to work with today for Keigan Madden should see him on or near the lead early in the mile & he is in with a shot to make it three in a row.

DOUG "SONNY" RANKIN

MEMORIAL RACE

APRIL 1944 – OCTOBER 2021



Doug "Sonny" Rankin is a name that not too many people don't know in regards to horses in Cape Breton. Even if you never meet him, you heard of him. He did it all.

He ran a public stable, bred horses, trained, raced successful stake horses, was a judge for Maritime Harness Racing Association, and did veterinary work for everyone who asked. He was a *true horseman*.

However, his true passion was driving. How he loved to get on a race bike and make a horse do what he wanted. He could get more from a horse than anyone and he knew a race better than anyone. Sonny studied a race card for 3 days after the race, and then studied the new card for 4 days before his next race. He would have his race mapped out in his head before he picked up the reins and could tell you who was going to do what before they knew what they were going to do.

He started driving Standardbreds at the age of 16 and after 30 years he had 15,032 drives, earned over \$1,000,000, had 2558 wins and an average of 30%. His driving career was cut short when he was in an accident that damaged his back so bad the doctors were amazed he was still walking. This gave him time to focus on training and breeding. Any new driver could always get advice from Sonny if they wanted it or not... sometimes it was with him scratching his head or patting them on the back.

This year, like all other years, the family and friends of Sonny miss him and his horse knowledge.

He gets an outside post to work with today for Kevin, but he is as versatile as it gets so even with the tricky post, he is the clear cut one to knock off in the opening leg of the late daily double.

#6 RANKED CONTENDER sat the pocket to Alritealritealrite last week, but the slow fractions gave the hot son of Tobago Cays no chance of collaring the tempo setter. The Big M & RC left two and that is exactly where they finished, pacing his own mile in 1:59 with a snappy :28 final quarter. The top class this week is handicapped by earnings made in their last five starts so he gets blessed with the dreaded post 6 today. The Big M will have to work out a trip from the far outside post, but he is razor sharp right now so he rounds out another chalky looking exactor.

#4 REVENANT the classy 36-time winner took his talents to the Inverness Raceway on July 15th & raced well in their top class finishing third to McLand & What's Up Doc, pacing his own mile in 1:59.3 with a 28.4 final quarter. He returns to his home track & the top-class Winners Over, where he has been a staple for the last number of years. A middle of the gate post to work with today for Shawn Lynk & I like him to round out the triactor.

DONALD C RANKIN MEMORIAL RACE



Donald was a standardbred driver, trainer, breeder and racing family patriarch.
Peggy was the heart and sole of Donmar Farms.

Donald was born in Judique, Inverness Co and moved to the Sydney area as a young man. Peggy also was born in Judique, married her sweetheart Donald, on one of her trips back home from Boston where she was working. The pair raised 8 children together who are all animal lovers, but have a special spot in their hearts for horses.

Donald was a livestock dealer that bought and sold cattle and work horses all over Cape Breton. In the early fifties he won a racehorse on a ticket and this chance occurrence eventually turned him to standardbred racing. He was a driver and trainer of such horses as Celia Sharon, Clean legs, and Florence Harmony. He passed the driving torch to his children and focused on training and breeding. At Donmar Farms he had some great sires like Rick's Colt and Brewsters Blue Chip. He was the first maritime breeder to produce both a sub 2:00 trotter – Donmar Shalom 1:59.4 and pacer Donmar Rain – 1:57.2.

Donmar Farms became a hub of activity for people near and far. True to their Inverness roots, every visitor had to come in for tea and something to eat. Peggy could make a meal in no time from almost nothing and she was renowned for her good cooking. No one went away hungry because Peggy would always say with a kind smile and a head tilt, "Go ahead, have just one more"

Donald was a member of the Cape Breton Horsemen Hall of Fame and was also presented with the Glen Kennedy Award from Atlantic Standardbred Breeders for contributions to maritime breeding. Peggy was the first female inductee into the Cape Breton Horsemen Hall of Fame and was very proud of that designation.

Donald and Peggy encouraged their family in the racing industry. Doug "Sonny", Joe, Cahill, Darleen, and Donnie who have raced in over 82,000 races, won nearly 12,000 times and earned nearly \$30,000,000. The Rankin name is synonymous with harness racing in Cape Breton, the Maritimes and Canada.

This race pays homage to Donald and Peggy Rankin, their accomplishment and love of horses.

During the 1990's until the closing of Tartan Downs he drove a lot of horses like Stacey's Echo where he got her 100th win in her final racing season, Peppy Alche, Biggie, Garden Mist, Island Quincy, Why Worry Us and Kings Castle.



When racing returned to Northside Downs that was his most enjoyable years driving horses like Julia Down, Ramnoram, Iona Katie, Forbidden Fantasy, Andro Peanut, Western Cooking, Marching Band, Jake Sully, Pictonian Fancypas and Private Practice.



Gerry drove on every track in the Maritimes and a few in Ontario. When Gerry wasn't driving, he was an amazing blacksmith. Gerry was a magician when it came to putting shoes on horses and making sure they didn't hit their knees. No one could do that better than Gerry.
